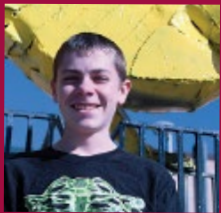
The Pride of the Park's drum major, **Jacob Patterson '19**, plays nine instruments and has been in band since sixth grade. He describes his love for music as "a different language."

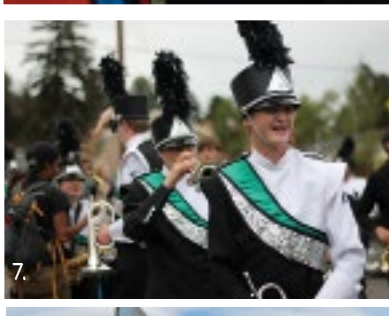


Banding TOGETHER
