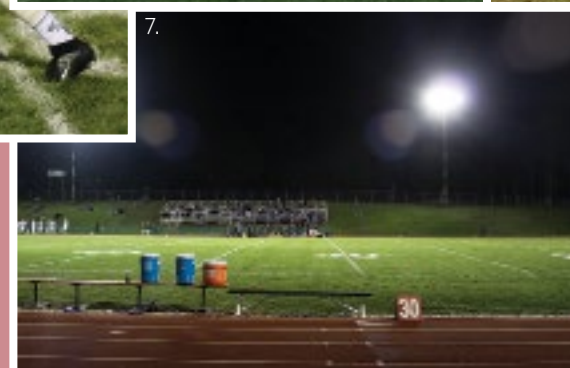
"I just want to be able to go out there and play under the friday night lights," Sophomore Jacob Simpson '20 explains, "Above all, I want to go out there and try to win games!"
