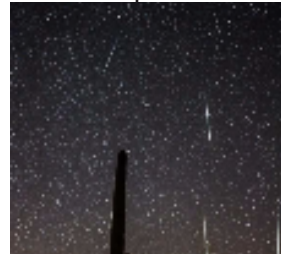
In August, a 1962 Ferrari 250 GTO was sold for \$48.4 million at an auction in California, making it the most expensive car ever sold at an auction.

On October 28th, the Boston Red Sox dominated the World Series against The LA Dodgers, winning 4 of their 5 games.

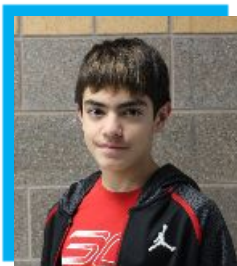

The Geminid meteor shower was at its peak December 3rd through the 17th, flinging around 120 meteors per hour at Earth.

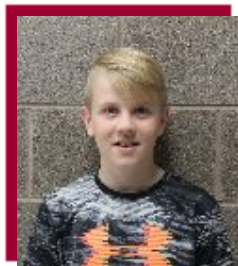
