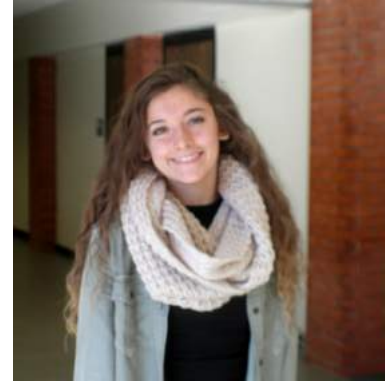
SARA FUCHSCRUBER

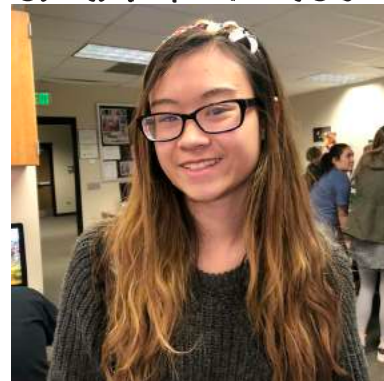
SARAH ROBERTS
