Mr. Risdon holds his two dogs, Gabby and Mya. They were both rescued from abusive owners, and had finally found a good home.



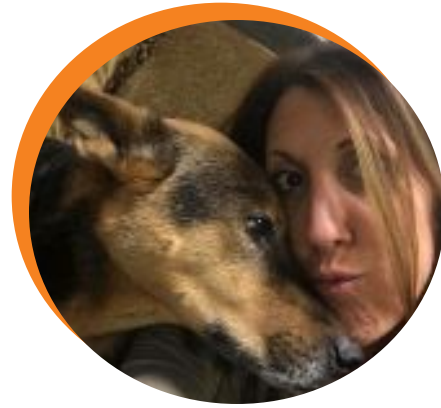
Crazy For Canines

Mr. Fong and his dog Sunny take a stroll on the CMS track. Sometimes they run into different wellness classes on their walks.



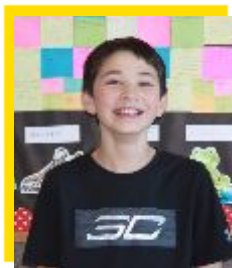
Cuddly Critter
