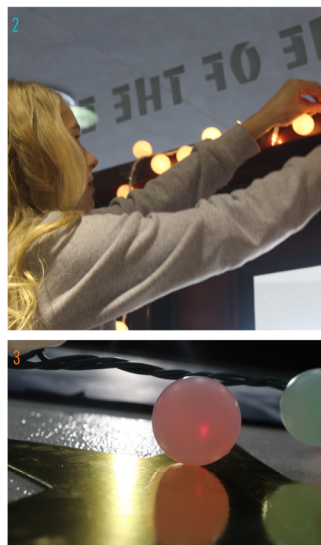
Members of Student Council make buttons for clubs and sports teams.
