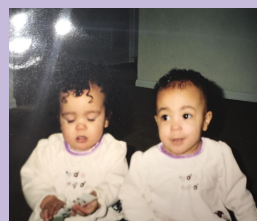

We share everything, so it will be weird when we are apart.

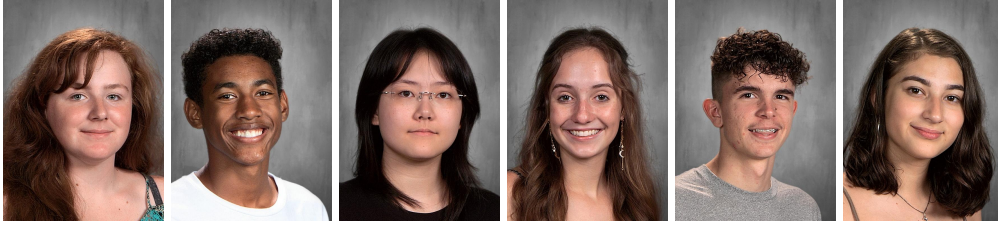
Having a twin is pretty fun. We argue a lot, but it's like having built in best friend.
