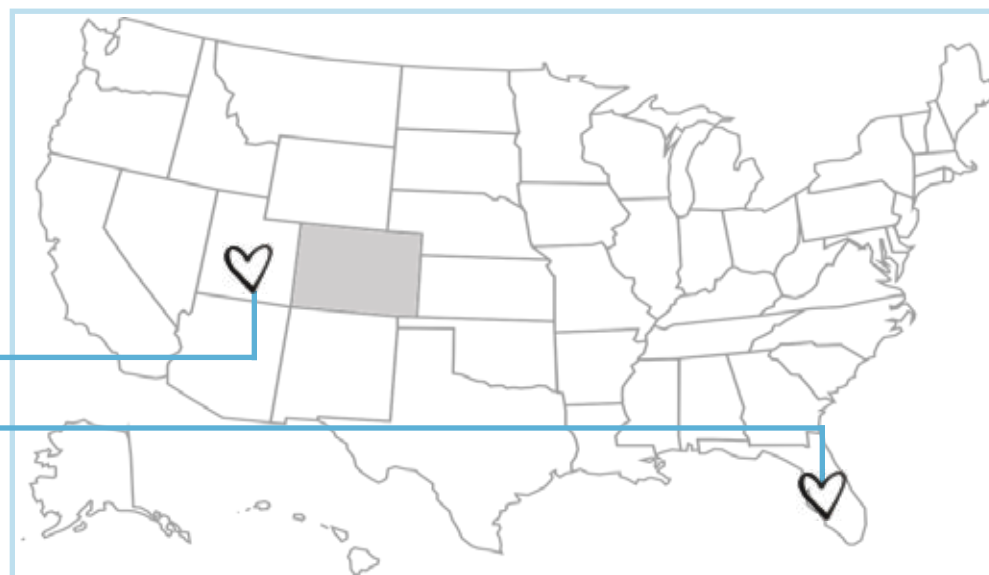
Seniors talk about their prom dresses
