"My dream car would be a Honda Civic because I would like a nice spacious car where I can go out to eat with friends or family."

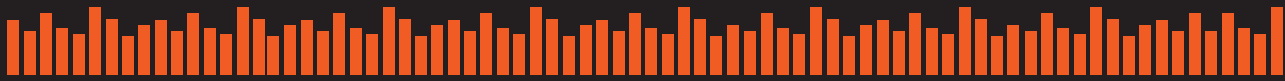
