A club that teaches students about the judicial system by learning and performing a fake court case (called a Mock Trial).

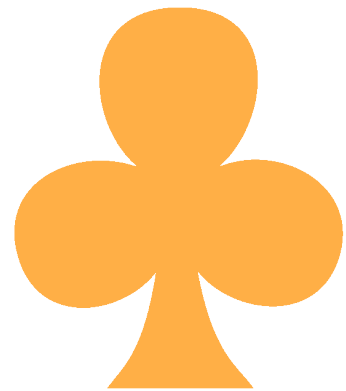
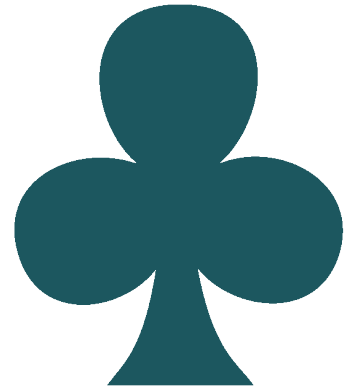
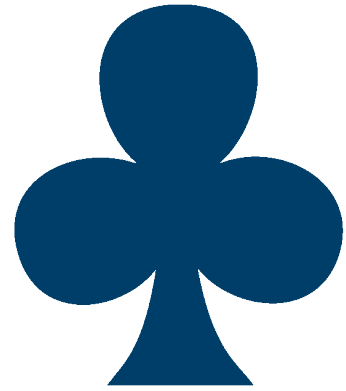
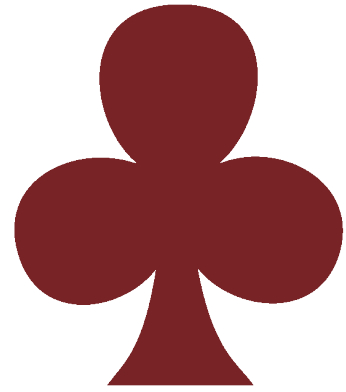
The program gives students an opportunity to enhance public speaking and comprehension skills, increase argumentative and persuasive skills, meet new people, and much more.
