

Our BHS Engineering Club is a team of creative innovators and problem solvers who compete in regional STEM competitions and strive to develop the skills of scientists & engineers.



A plethora of projects for our non-profit organization Bal Swan Preschool-painting, cleaning, landscaping, and fundraising!






