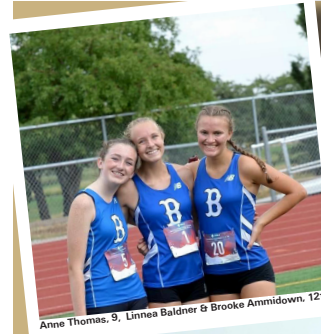


## Running For Miles

"I am really happy I joined this team even though it was a challenge and something I had never done before. At the beginning I did not know that many people but now I have made so many good friends," said Byren.

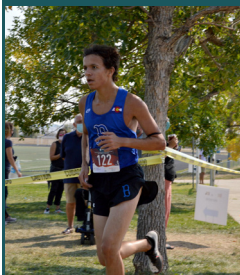
