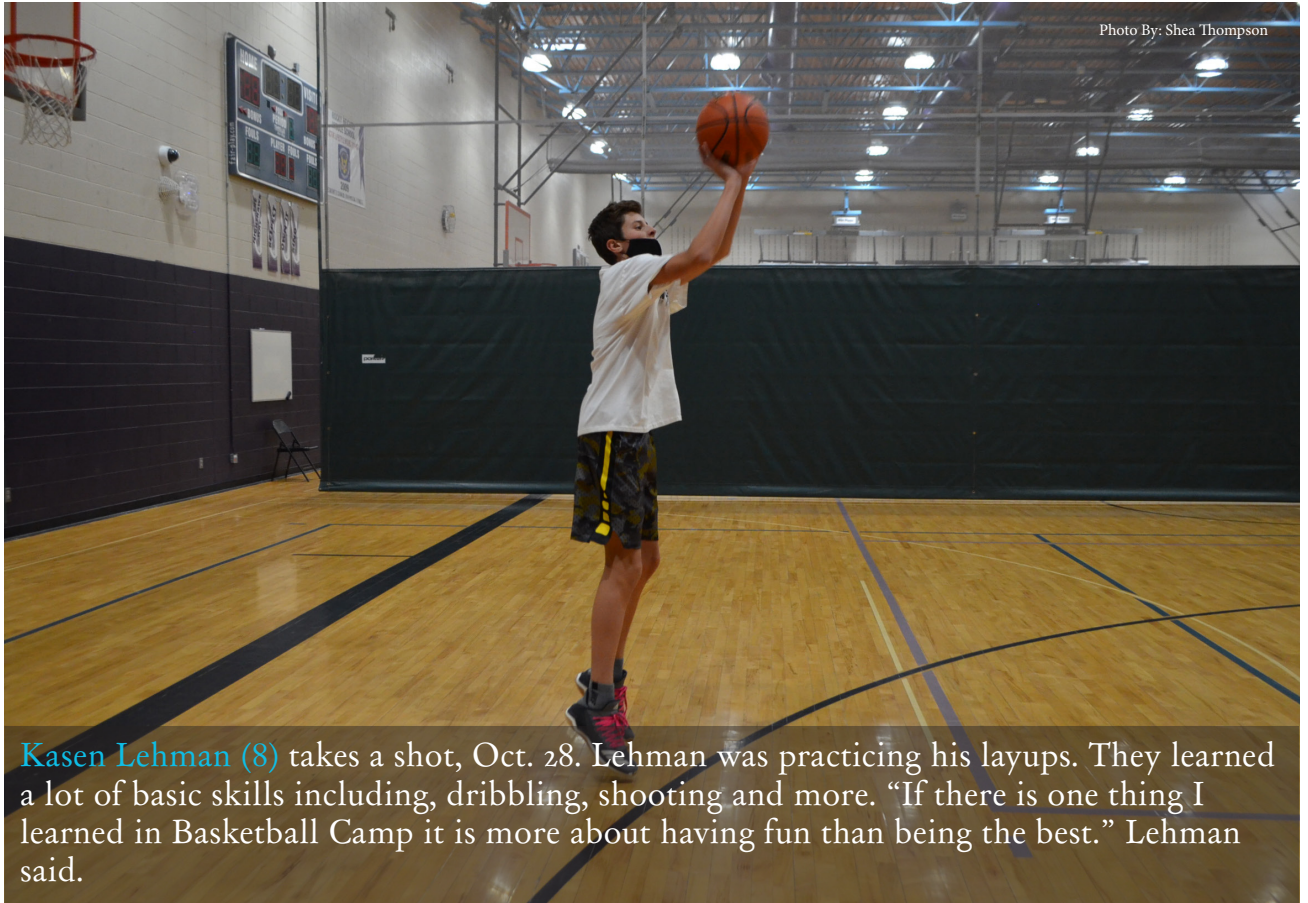


8th Grade Boys Practice in Basketball Camp
