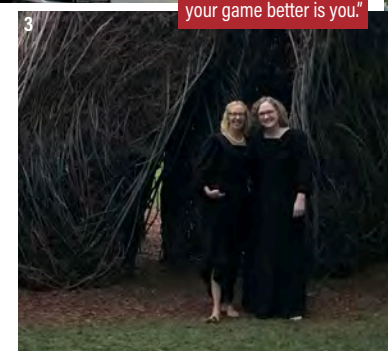
4. FR. TOM ROCHFORD is a native Coloradoan. "I love hiking, even in winter, when the snow brings its own range of color," Rochford said.
