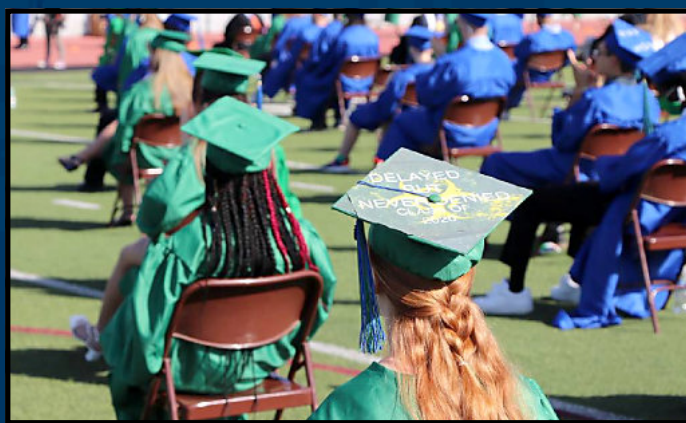
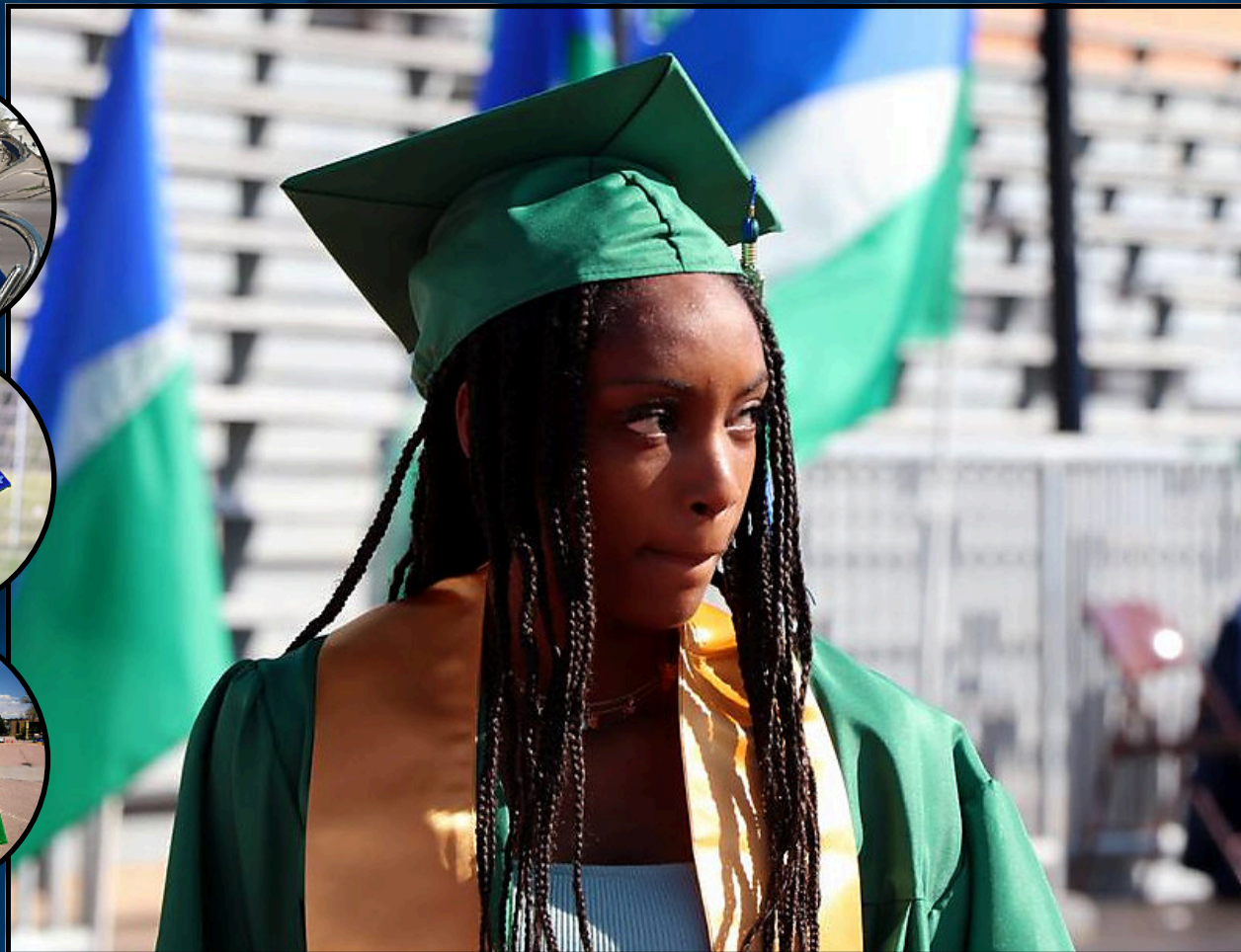


The year like no other...
