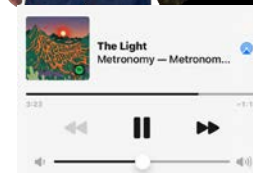
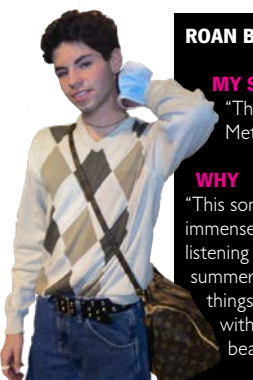
MY SONG "Heat Waves" by Glass Animals

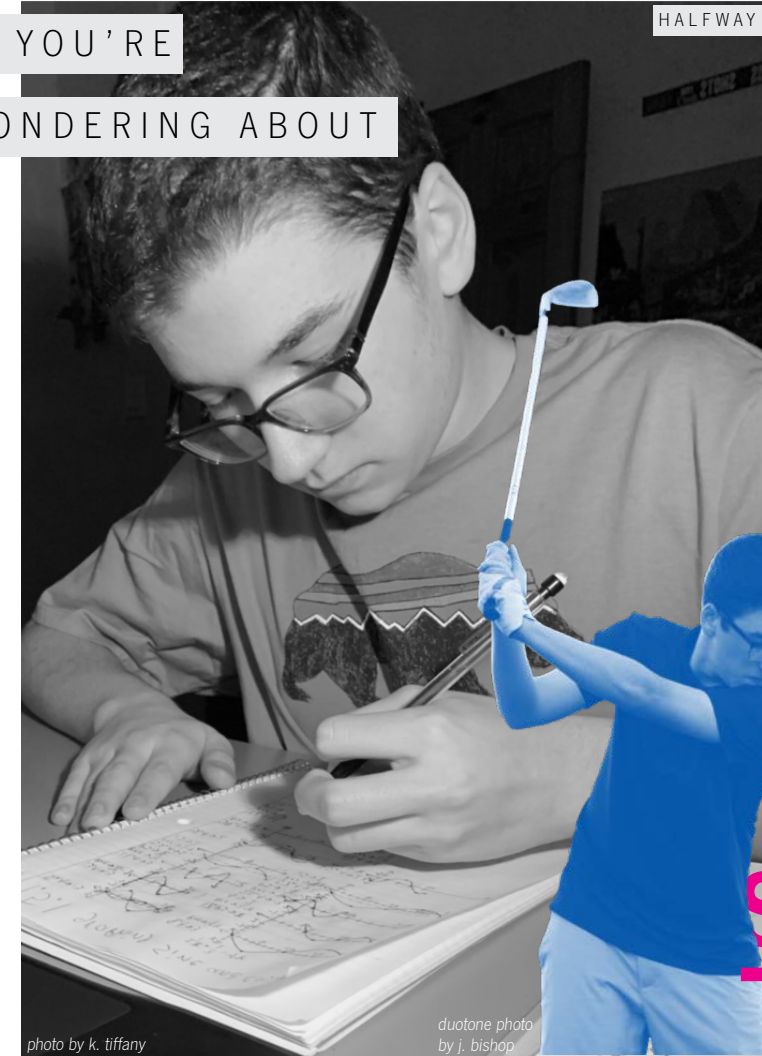
MY SONG "The Light" by Metronomy
