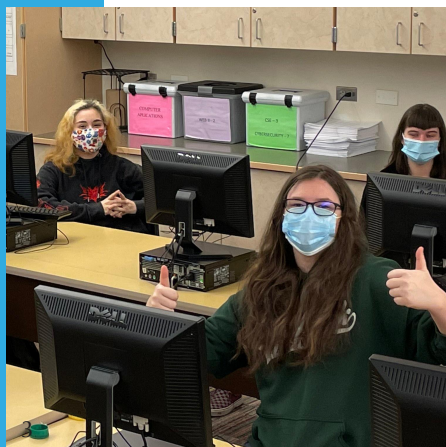
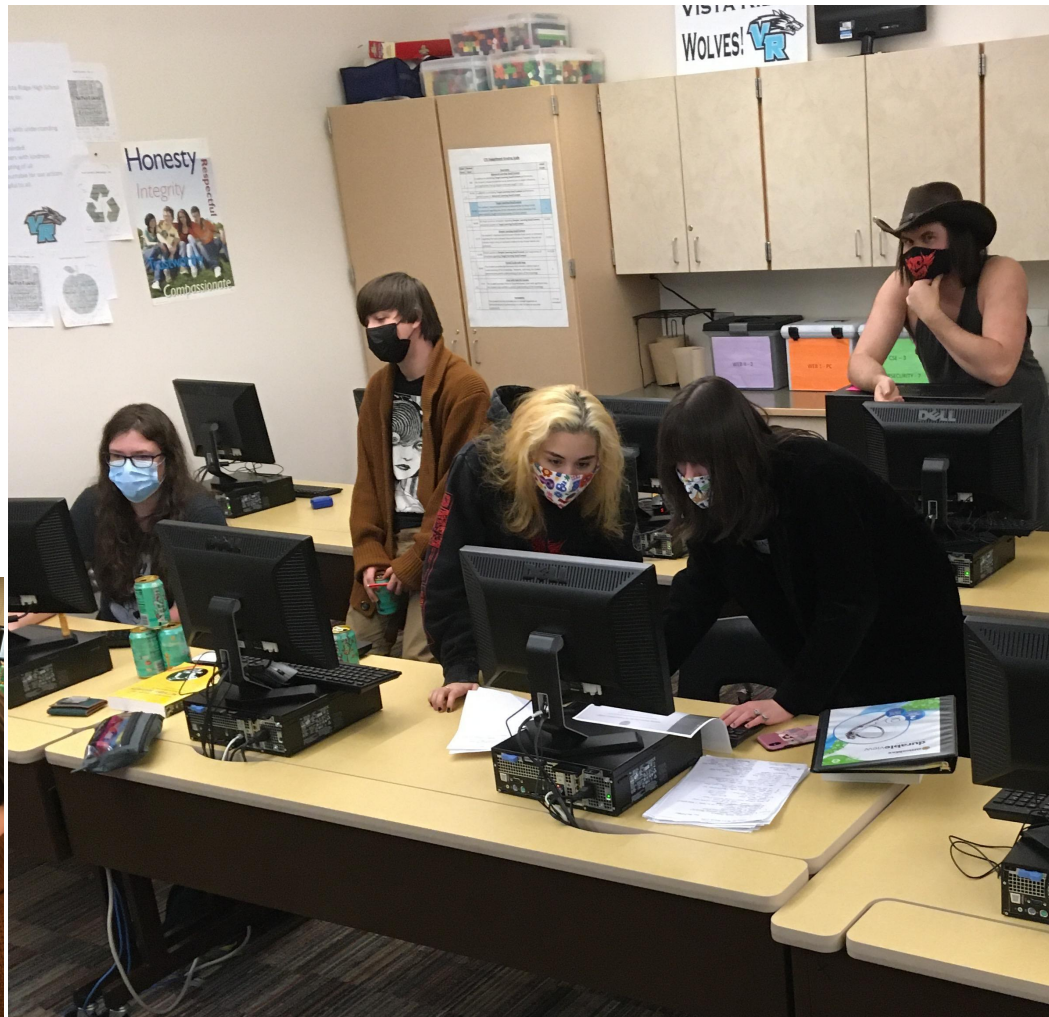
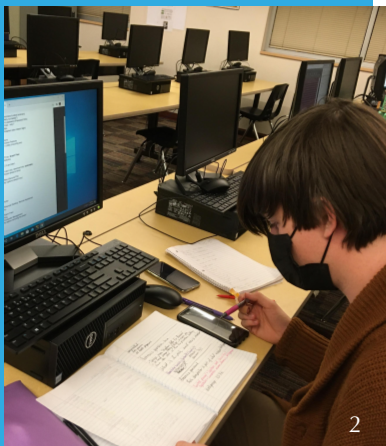
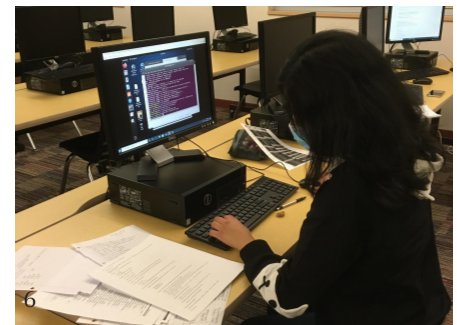


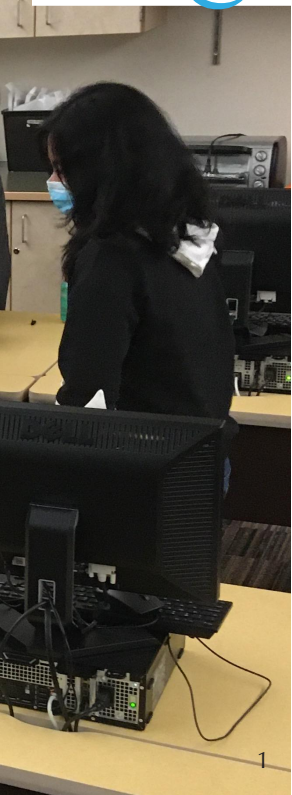
LOOKING BEYOND THE SCREEN

6. **Christiana Condes, 11**, is hard at work during competition.



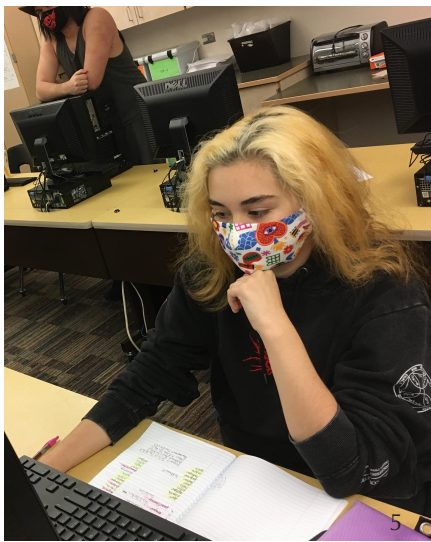
Digital Security in a Digital World
