

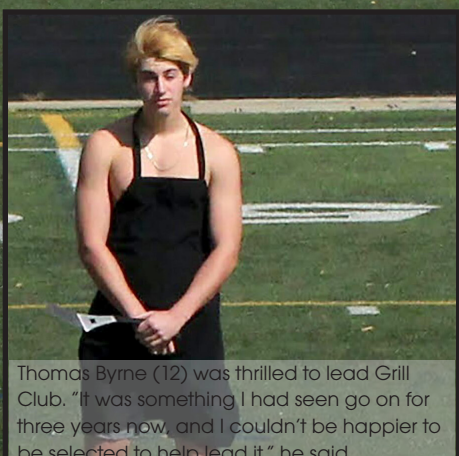

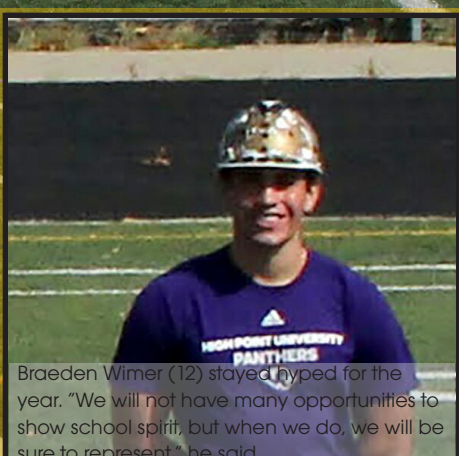
Jack Ford (12) was proud of his role in the Monarch Militia. "I want have fun at school events and encourage people to do the same," he said.
