MUSIC 'RED' TAYLOR SWIFT

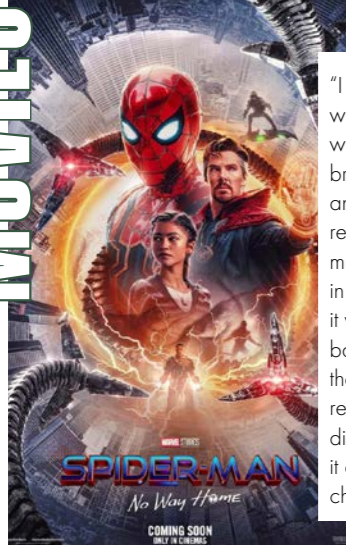

CONCERTS

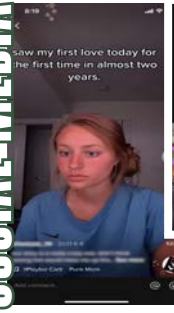


WHO: Nataly Chavez '23 traveled to New York with her cousin in October to see the Harry Styles Harryween Tour at Madison Square Garden.
