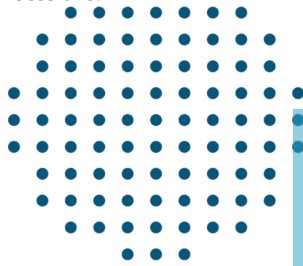
**CONCENTRATION IS KEY**
