

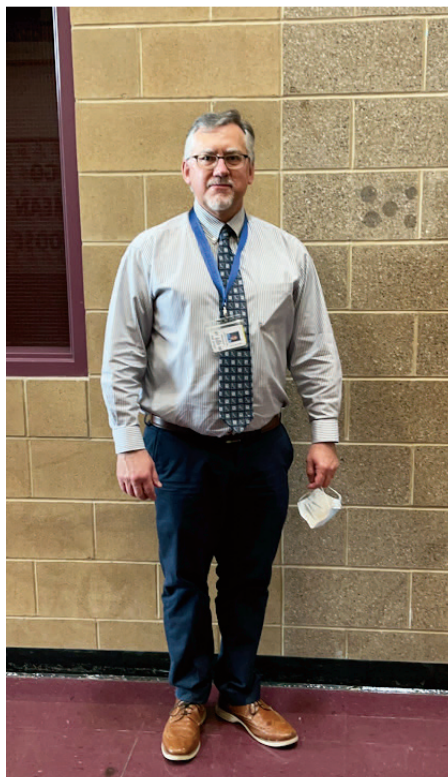


SMILES ON MANY FACES
