Mykayla Thompson, 11, "I just wanted to join, it sounded like fun."

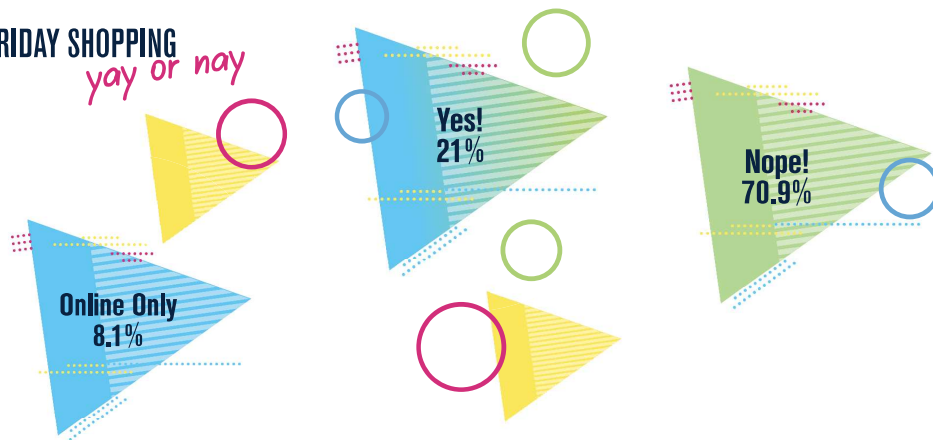


Madison Bradshaw, 12, "I like the amount of volunteering we do. It's a heavy volunteering kind of club."

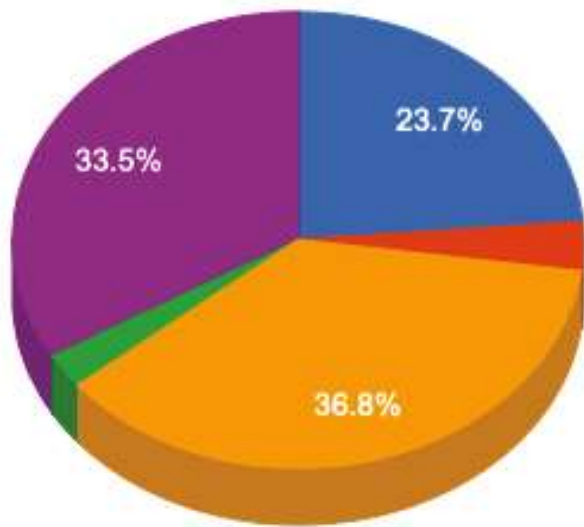
