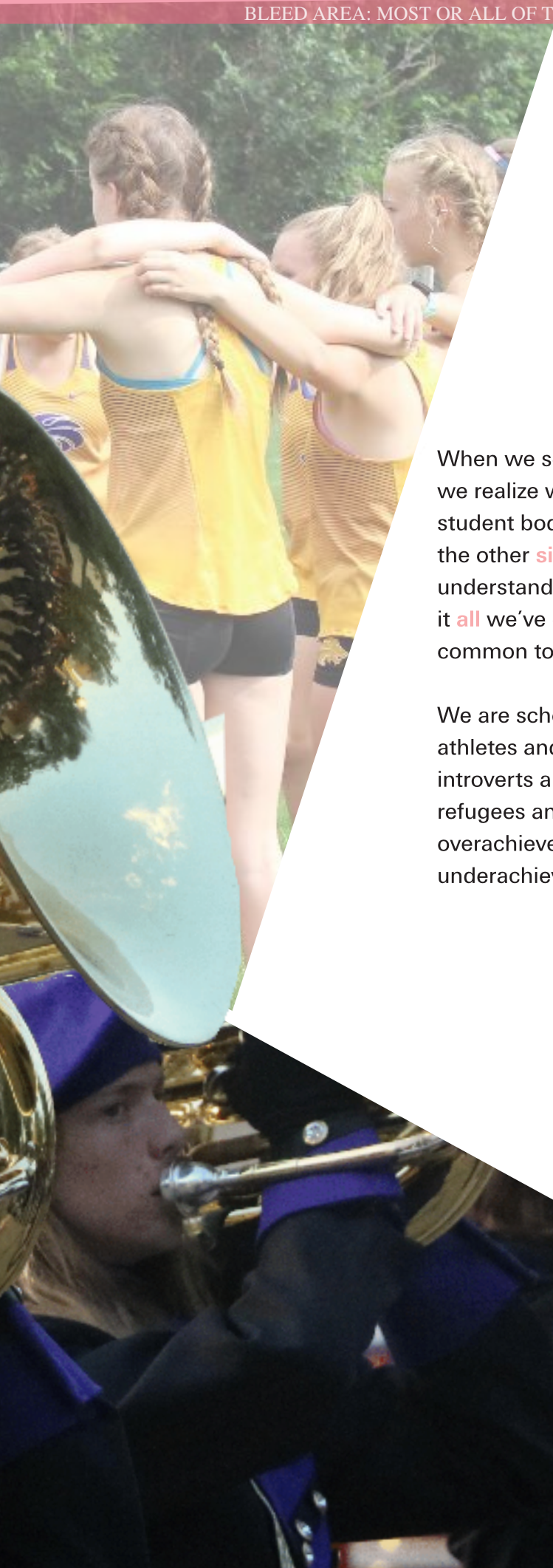


WARM UP RITUALS!
