





2007 As CT continues to grow, new clubs are introduced such as TSA. In addition, the very first class of seniors that attended CT all four year graduated in the spring of this year.



2010 This senior class was known as, "The Big 10". This was the first ever class name at CT. The next two years, senior classes followed, formally making it a new tradition recognized by everyone.










2017 Student favorite traditions for our seniors were introduced this year such as powder puff and senior sunrise. FUN FACT: The very first senior sunrise began
