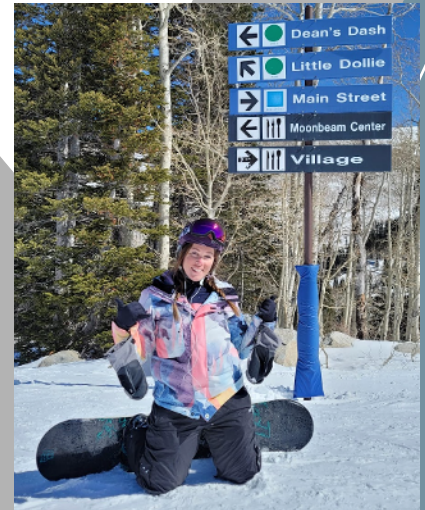


HEALING IT OUT
