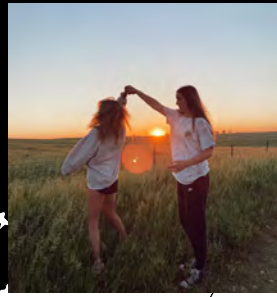

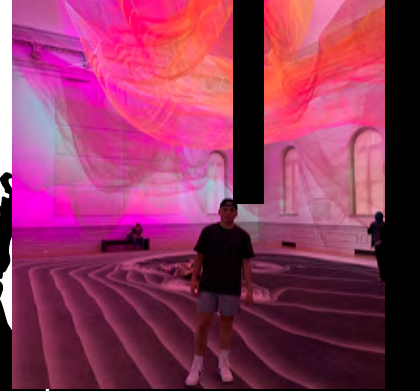
CROATIA
