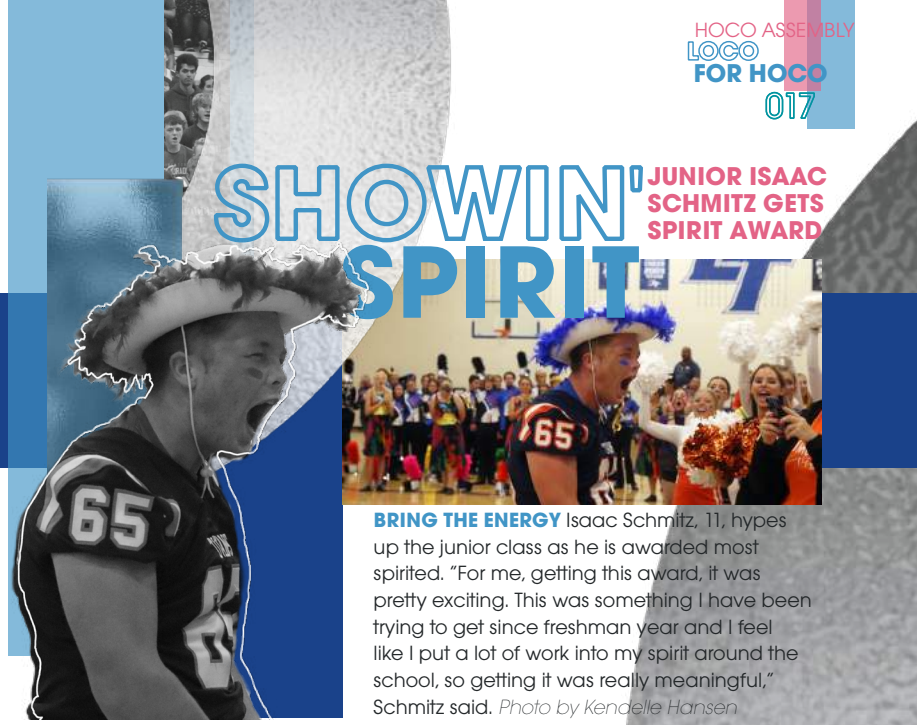
Leading the assembly allowed Rinow to reminisce on the Mr. Legends before him, who he had watched take on the role in previous years.

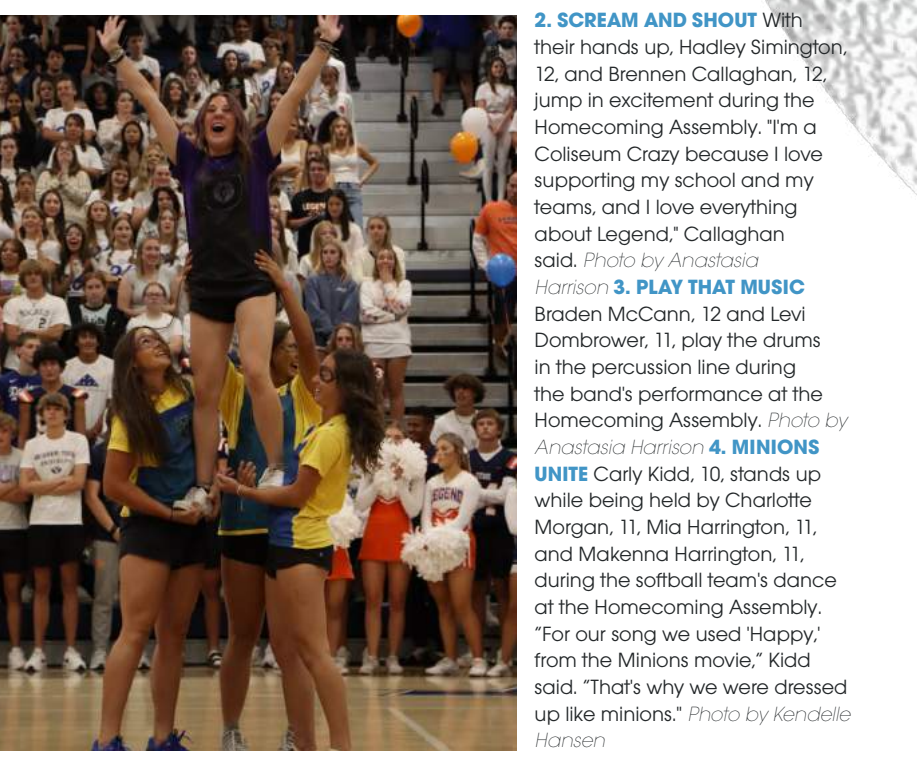
