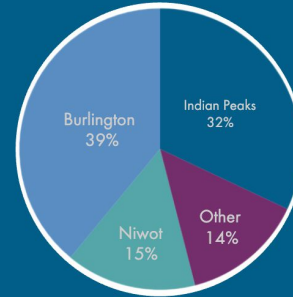
Welcome Crew
