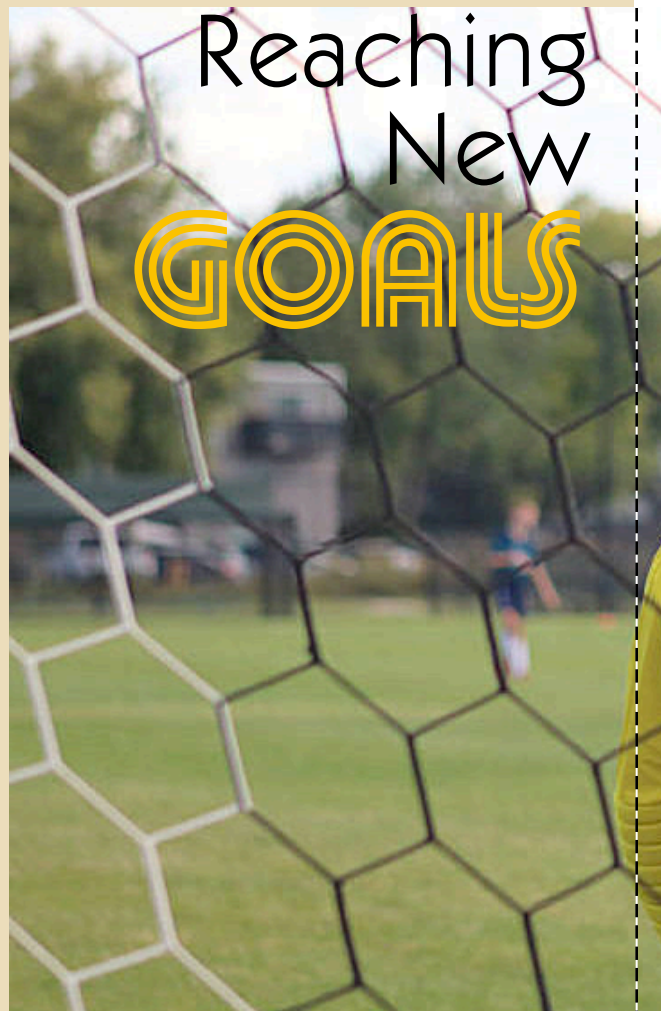


TRIM LINE TRIM LINE
