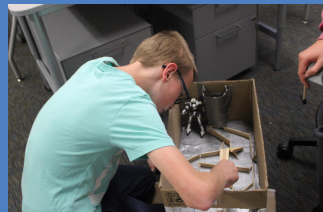


MINI GOLF 8TH GRADE STEAM LAB
