

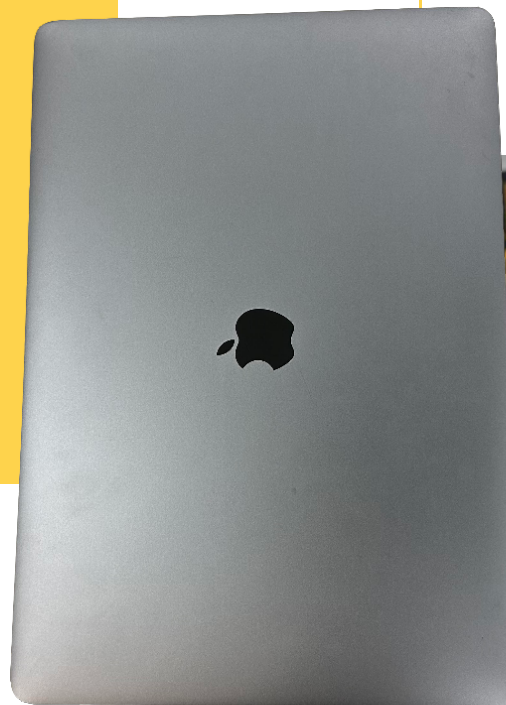

"I use Quizlet sometimes. You can study things you haven't already studied a lot."

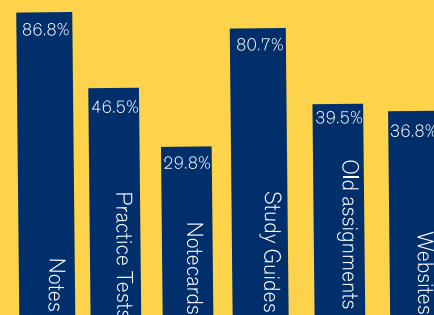

"Music keeps me zoned in and paying attention while studying and not worrying about the things around me."

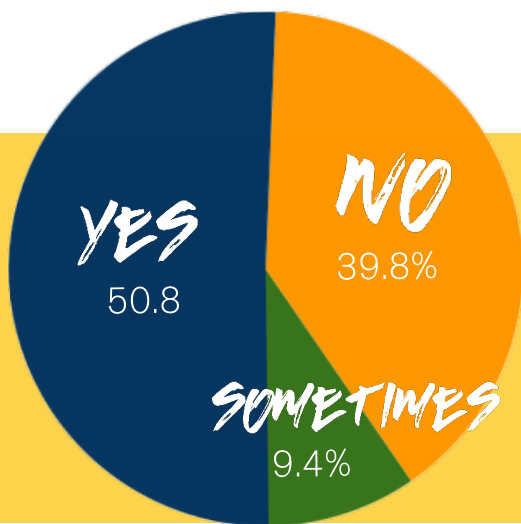


MOLLY WINSLOW, 10
"Math does not come as easily to me as other subjects, and I chose to take a higher level math class, which equates to more studying."

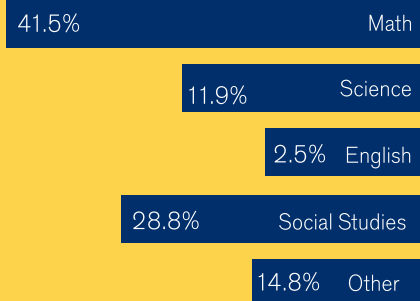


EMMANUEL MEDINA NEVAREZ, 11
