# clubs

The clubs at Odyssey were directed by the students. Students would approach an instructor to ask if they would be willing to sponsor a specific club. Once the club was approved by the administration, and there were at least five students who participated on a regular basis, the club happened and students were allowed to join. The clubs that were a part of Career Pathways were often a part of their Career and Technology Student Organization (CTSO). The students would compete at local, state, and national levels which allowed them to have a real-life, or industry, experience. The students were challenged to create a solution to a problem, and then present or demonstrate that solution in front of a group of judges.
