FALL

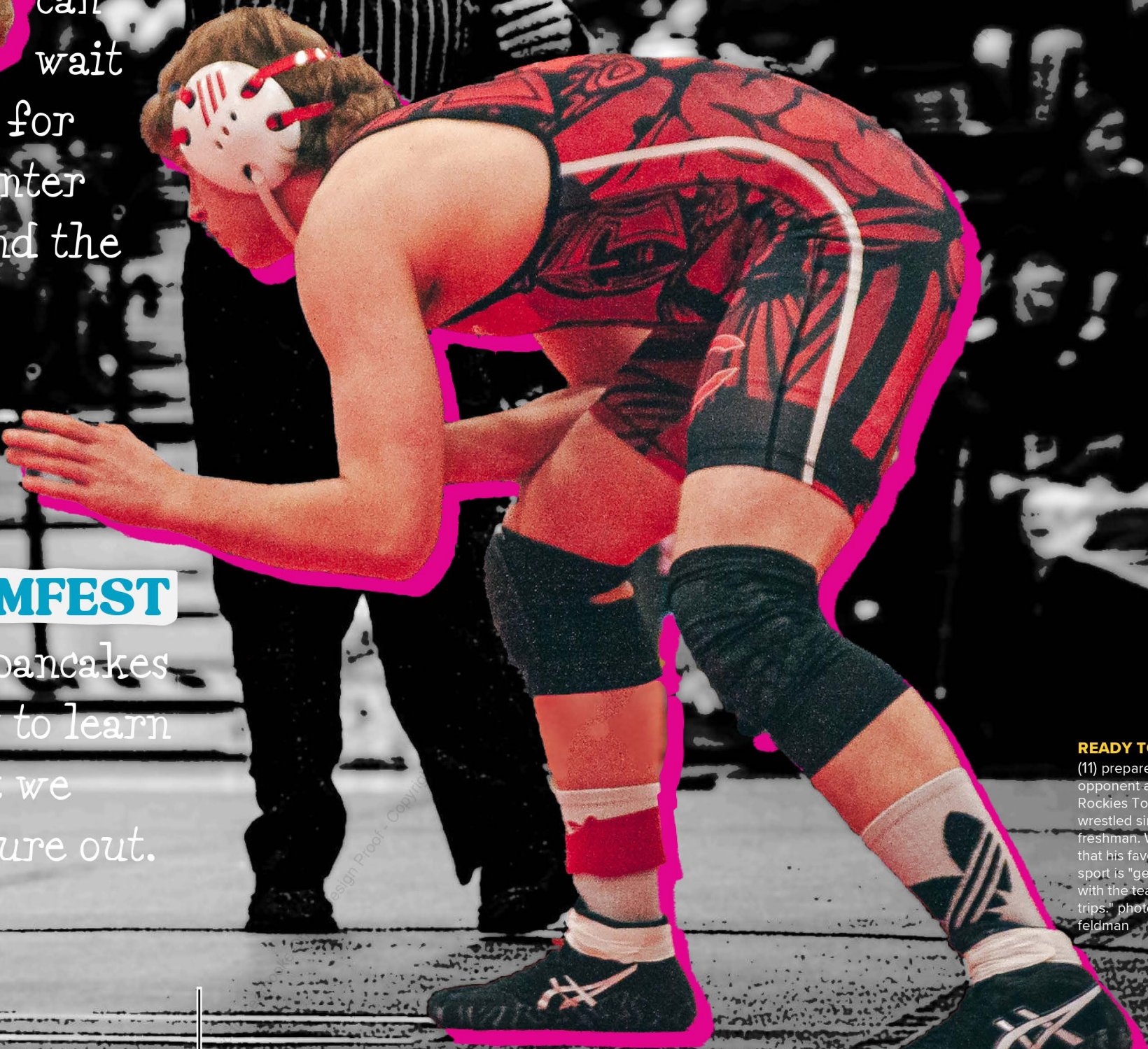
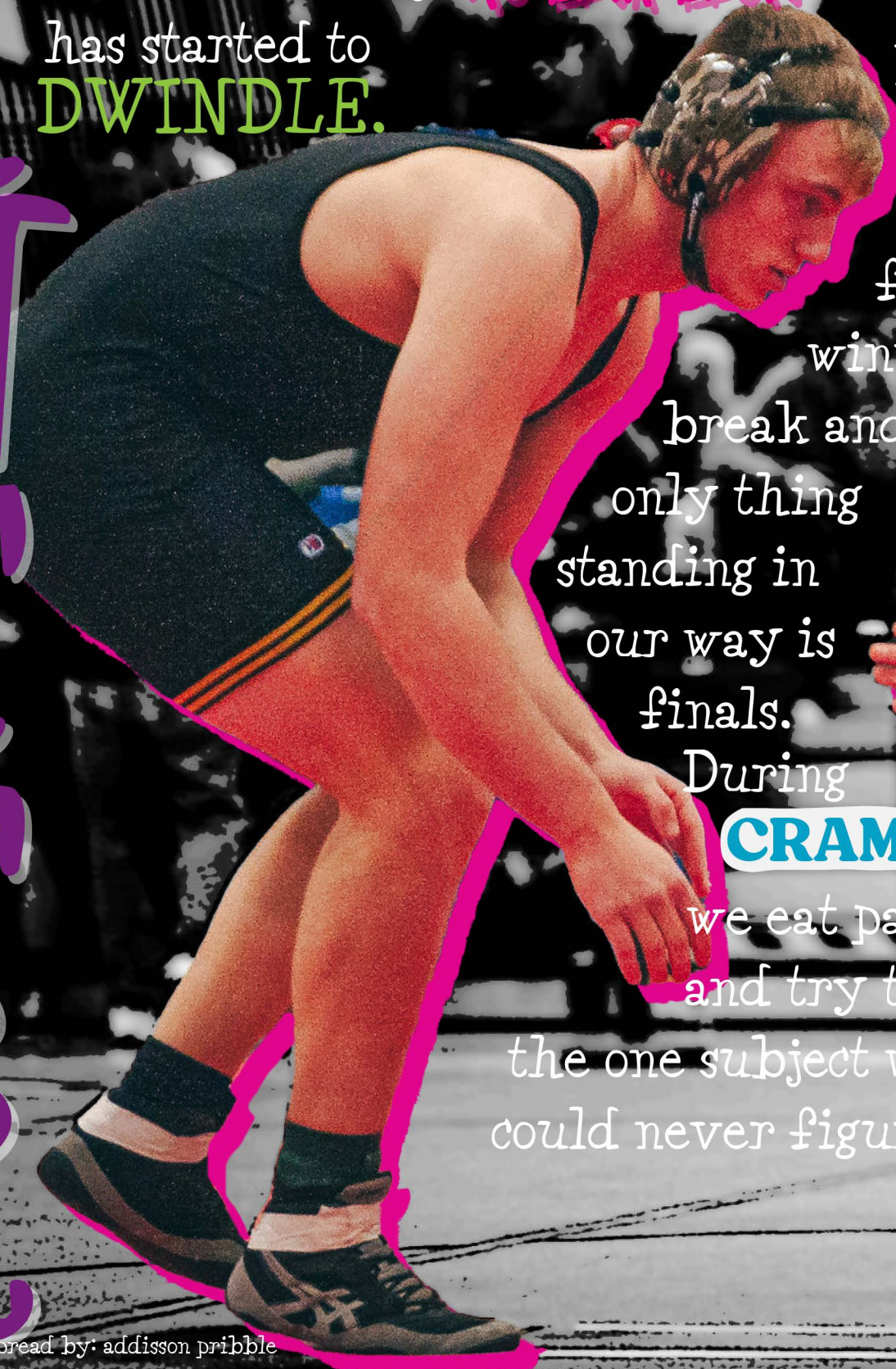
