



*State & Honor Choir

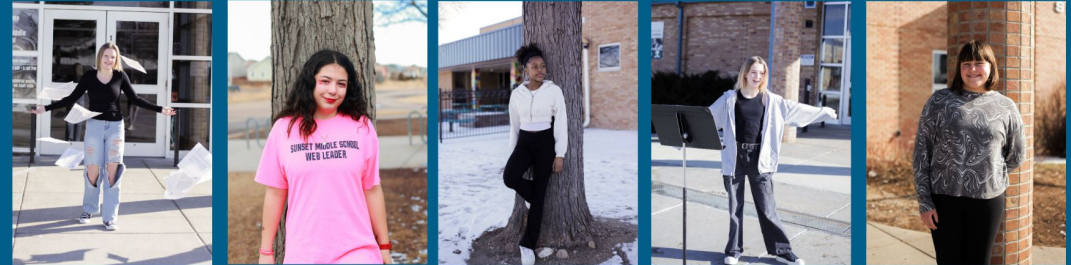
