Reports:

Western Slope Coordinator—Darcy

- No Western Slope Media Day due to the Denver convention
- Spring 2016 we will do something with the Western Slope
- Education Coordinator—Jess
 - CLAS Conference went really well!
 - Adam, Jack, Mark Newton, Justin, and Annie presented
 - CLAS and CHSPA needs a project--strand in Denver?
 - Presentations on the crossover between journalism and the language arts classroom. Remember that the deadline is Dec. 15--but we might be able to get an extension. (Saturday Strand would be best)
 - Jess will organize, Jack will ensure that it happens!
- Advocacy- Carrie
 - Not doing anything in the Spring because of JEA Denver
 - Next event will be SAW
 - We need to consider advocacy beyond issues with Student Press Rights and Issues with Principals
 - Relationship with CHSAA
 - Press Pass Issue
 - Cherry Creek High School requested extra press passes from CHSAA for the football state championship game and was denied.
 - We want to get reports at field level
 - We need to find ways to gain support for student reporting
 - Subcommittee to create a proposal to CHSAA to help students gain access to events especially to State Events
 - Karen, Adam, and Carrie to serve on committee
 - Focus on football (use it to set a precedent)
 - What other states have connections between their press association and activities association? Use these as examples.
 - Writing for CHSAA Now as a leverage point
 - We need to help CHSAA make connections to student Media organizations that are already functioning.

- Middle School Coordinator—Jed
 - DCSD has set up Cadres for media advisers (Kristi Rathburn is running high school level for print media, and Jed Palmer is running middle school for print media)
 - DCSD already has performance-based pay for coaches and their salary "bands" so media advisers in the county are meeting with the district to push for the same system to be used in the payment of media advisers--opportunity to propose a rubric.
 - Jed will share the rubric with the CHSPA board for feedback--how do you justify the time spent out of class
