### **Budget**

- Review 2013-2014 budget review was completed with clarifying discussion.
  - o Budget
- Jack presented a proposed budget. Budget approved with minor changes:
  - o Upon discussion, we added \$250 for CJE/MJE certification upon completion of the Press Law and Ethics certification.
  - o Adviser scholarships will be available for all professional development opportunities deemed appropriate by the board.
  - o Upon discussion, we added \$2,000 for a CASE booth and possible presenter time. CASE is July 23-24, 2014.
  - o CLAS monies will be added when more information is available.

#### Contests

- All-CO critique forms final comments/proofing. We will pilot a more narrative-driven judging form for news publications only this summer.
- Journalist of the Year (Greer, Benson, scholarships) and discussion?
- For Best of Colorado contests, reduce yearbook enrollment categories from 4 to 3 (see annual report for details).
