Meeting called to order - Called to order at 1:08 p.m.

- 1. Welcome
- 2. Reading, correction, and acceptance of <u>December 2016</u> minutes. Corrected and approved!
- 3. Officer Reports
 - a. Executive Director, Jack Kennedy
 - i. Winter Thaw report
 - We had fewer attendees than the previous year. Same time of year and good program. Budget reflects 25 participants and we actually had 11. The good news was that expenses were zero dollars!
 - 2. Jack published a post on our website that included handouts and materials from the day.
 - ii. CHPC report
 - We ended up with 80 students and 18 schools. We ended up with good submissions from students. This was very successful. Next year, we are hoping to get the governor.
 - iii. Membership update and Best of Colorado update.
 - 1. We have a record number of memberships: 202 paid member media plus 6 sister schools.
 - 2. This helps explain why we are way over our projected budget.
 - 3. Jack did a breakdown because of Best of Colorado.

 - b. NP Class 1: 26
 - c. NP Class 2: 45
 - d. NP Class 3: 34
 - e. YB Class 1: 26
 - f. YB Class 2: 22
 - g. YB Class 3: 21
 - h. Video: 25 (up by a few)
 - 4. There could be a question on the membership form where members choose their enrollment category (if a school wanted to "play up a level.". Newspaper and website are combined for BOC. If you have both, you can enter two, as in a paper entry and a web entry in breaking news.
 - 5. Next year, Jack is phasing out the four-media discount.
 - iv. Financial report through March 24
 - 1. Proposal to pay critique judges \$40.
 - 2. See Jack's financial report.
 - 3. We are for the most part, on track for everything.
 - 4. Anything in bold is done and can be considered a final figure.
 - 5. Because we budget conservatively, we have a \$4000 overage from J-Day.
 - 6. We are paying Adam to run the PLE course.
 - 7. We have some expenses coming: \$250 prize to winners of the year for contests. Will be paid out in May.

- 8. Fall coverage contest was \$900 in vouchers, so no actual cash.
- g. In June, Jack would like to hear about what the Board would like the store to look like. Shirts? Stickers? Continue notebooks/folders?
- b. President Adam Dawkins
 - i. Staff Spotlight Series -2 entries so far. How do we encourage this? Should we set up a week next fall that we build up to and publish during that week - one each day - like JEA Scholastic Journalism Week?
 - 1. Hashtag for a month, which could be used to train new advisers.
 - 2. Set up "sister school" that encourages participation. Pairing weekly celebrations of staff as we get closer to J-Day.
 - 3. At the bottom of a CSMA newsletter, we can also highlight a staff.
 - ii. PLE Certification Course will conclude at reTHINK this year. Plans for next year? What works what doesn't? Feedback.
 - 1. Keep it rolling? Yes, it is so important.
 - 2. 4 3-hour in person sessions. You revise or add to publication policies & procedures. Create PLE outline for a unit. Develop one full lesson. Teach lesson; write reflection. Final piece is a test. Can get one credit from Adams State. This year it was paired with CSMA Board Meetings. Second in person meeting was Winter Thaw. In the future, we could make it work with another CSMA event.
 - 3. Other states have asked Adam about this.
 - 4. Reminder: We need to get together with CASE.
 - Next year, we offer it. In June, Adam needs to come with a calendar for the next year.
- c. Immediate Past President, Justin Daigle
 - i. Nominations for 2017-19
 - Right now, who do we have? We don't know yet. Bios need to be sent in April.
 Voting in May. New Board meets in June.
 - iii. There are six positions available. Board members need to think about their continuing involvement and recruit for additional positions.
- d. Vice-President, Annie Gorenstein Falkenberg
 - i. Chronological yearbook category has been revised. Umbrella = chronological?
 We will leave it for another year and revisit.

 - Esteban Arellano from Stanley Lake was our Greer winner. Strong depth of reporting demonstrated in his portfolio. Portfolio was converted to a website for JEA JOY. Sheila, Kristi, and Steve were the judges.
